- If you want to remove the center vent in your Mk5 Golf or Jetta, this tray will provide a great place to stash a phone or other small items.

Tools Required for Installation

- Putty knife/trim removal tool
- T-15 torx

Installation

- Use the putty knife to pry out the plastic piece near the windshield.



- Use a T-15 Torx driver to remove the single torx screw holding the vent in place.



Mk5 Dash Tray

- I suppose you don't have to do this part but after this I removed the cover for the vent



- Then I removed the vent assembly with my putty knife.



- I then removed the two screws that were not holding the vent in place so that I could use them after installing the dash tray to secure it in place.



- I then marveled at how well made and engineered the dash tray is as it has a little piece to close off the vent and everything.



- Then I put the dash tray in. It snaps into place with relative ease.



- Then use those two screws you pulled out earlier to screw the tray in.
- The screw you pulled out earlier to release the vent assembly is not used with the dash tray. I just put it back where I got it out so I didn't loose it or anything



- Now put the rubber non slip cover in the tray and admire your work and how well this piece matches.
